How to Plan a Fundraising Event

Choose a venue and date

Try to use a convenient location that works well for your chosen event and also consider the time of year you would like to hold the event. Make sure it does not clash with any other activities going on in your community.

Decide on your event

Targets

Set a fundraising target but keep it realistic and achievable.

Publicise and Promote your event

Contact your local media, (local papers and radio stations) put up posters in your local community, (pubs, social clubs, schools, night classes, GP surgery and the local gym) give family and friends a copy to put in their places of work. Set up a Justgiving or Virgin Money Giving page where you can email friends, relatives and colleagues so they can donate online.

Invite Guests

Invite as many people as you can, local dignitaries, as the more people who you have the more money you can raise for Mesothelioma UK.

Support and Help

Get your friends, family and work colleagues to help you. Write a list with set jobs that they can choose themselves, and which they feel most comfortable with, for example sourcing raffle prizes from your local shops, supermarkets and businesses; display posters and sell tickets; organisation on the day of the event.

Donations

Ask your guests to complete a [Gift Aid form](#) for any donations made. This will enable Mesothelioma UK to claim an extra 28p in every £1 donated raised at no extra cost to you or the person making the donation.

Thanks

Thanking everyone who is involved, whether it has been through them supporting you in the organisation or through sponsorship or just turning up to the event on the day is one of the most important things to remember. Let them know how much you appreciate their help and support, keep them informed at the different stages and let them know how much they have helped to raise money for Mesothelioma UK, and lastly thank your guests for their support.
